DISCOUNT ON TAXES!!!

All taxes have been sent out in the mail. In order to receive the 5% discount available on your current year taxes, the invoice will have to be paid in full by January 31st. There is a smaller discount available for February. If your current year taxes are paid in full by February 29th you are entitled to a 3% discount. Any resident who turns 65 years of age in 2020 will be eligible for an additional 5% senior's discount. You may be exempt from Poll Tax if your previous year's income is below the basic personal exemption for the previous year. The amount for 2019 was \$12,069.00. You must have a copy of last year's tax return notice of assessment to qualify.
