HAPPY NEW YEAR!!!

On behalf of council & staff of the Town of Reidville, may your new year bring you health and happiness.

DISCOUNT ON TAXES!!!

All taxes have been sent out in the mail. In order to receive the 5% discount available on your current year taxes, the invoice will have to be paid in full by January 31st. There is a smaller discount available for February. If your current year taxes are paid in full by February 28th you are entitled to a 3% discount. Any resident who turns 65 years of age in 2021 will be eligible for an additional 5% senior's discount. You may be exempt from Poll Tax if your previous year's income is below the basic personal exemption for the previous year. The amount for 2020 was \$12,069.00. You must have a copy of last year's tax return notice of assessment to qualify.

STREETLIGHT OUT

If you notice a streetlight out in your area you can report it to Newfoundland Power by logging into the website www.newfoundlandpower.com and click on the link "Report a Streetlight Out". If this is not an option please call the town office.

GARBAGE/RECYCLING

Please note that all garbage (both commercial and personal) must be in clear plastic bags. Recycling must follow the regulations put out by Western Regional Waste Management. If garbage or recycling does not comply with these regulations it will not be picked up by our Garbage Contractor as they are the ones who incur the fines when unloading at the transfer sites.

If you would like to pay your taxes online, you can do this in two ways:

- You can set up the town as a biller in your online banking. Search for "Reidville, Town of" in the list of billers. Your account number is located on your invoice on the top left corner under your mailing address.
