All taxes have been sent out in the mail. In order to receive the 5% discount available on your current year taxes, the invoice will have to be paid in full by January 31st. There is a smaller discount available for February. If your current year taxes are paid in full by February 29th you are entitled to a 3% discount. Any resident who turns 65 years of age in 2024 will be eligible for an additional 5% senior's discount.

DOMESTIC WOOD CUTTING PERMIT

Permits for the Town's domestic wood cutting block are now available. Permits can be applied for and printed online at my.gov.nl.ca - this is the preferred method for obtaining a permit and you will have your permit immediately. If you are unable to do this online, you can call Forestry in Pasadena at 709-686-2071 to make arrangements to have your permit mailed to you or to pick up in person.

ELECTRONIC PAYMENT OPTION FOR TAXES

If you would like to pay your taxes online, you can do this in two ways:

- You can set up the town as a biller in your online banking. Search for "Reidville, Town of" in the list of billers. Your account number is located on your invoice on the top left corner under your mailing address.
- You can send an email transfer to the town using the email address: townofreidville@nf.aibn.com
Use **taxes** as the password.
