DISCOUNT

There is a discount available for February. If your current year taxes are paid in full by February 28th you are entitled to a 3% discount. Any resident who turns 65 years of age in 2022 will be eligible for an additional 5% senior's discount. You may be exempt from Poll Tax if your previous year's income is below the basic personal exemption for the previous year. The amount for 2021 was \$13,808.00. You must have a copy of last year's tax return notice of assessment to qualify.

FIREARMS SAFETY/ HUNTERS EDUCATION

The town, in conjunction with CNA, is looking at offering these courses in the coming months. The Firearm's Safety course is a 12 hr course at the cost of \$104.65 for 18+ or \$60.95 for ages 12-17. The Hunter's Education course is a 7 hr course at the cost of \$67.85 for 18+ or \$17.25 for ages 12-17. If you are looking to apply for big game license and you want to carry your own gun you are required to have both courses. If you would be interested in doing one or both please call the town office to register. We are unsure of the maximum number we can have right now so it will be on a first call, first serve basis.

ELECTRONIC PAYMENT OPTION FOR TAXES

If you would like to pay your taxes online, you can do this in two ways:

- You can set up the town as a biller in your online banking. Search for "Reidville, Town of" in the list of billers. Your account number is located on your invoice on the top left corner under your mailing address.
- You can send an email transfer to the town using the email address: townofreidville@nf.aibn.com Use **taxes** as the password.

If you need clarification on either of these options, please feel free to call the town office.

STREETLIGHT

If you notice a streetlight out in your area you can report it to Newfoundland Power by logging into the website www.newfoundlandpower.com and click on the link "Report a Streetlight Out". If this is not an option please call the town office.

SNOW CLEARING

PLEASE BE ADVISED: It is illegal to dump snow onto a public roadway, the RCMP have been notified and will be making rounds!!

A number of cases have been reported to the council office and further action will have to be taken if this continues.

Please be sure that you have your garbage box and path (if required to get to the box) cleared of snow on garbage day. If it is not cleared your garbage will not be taken. It is too time consuming and difficult for the contractor to be cleaning off the top of garbage boxes or trying to get through deep snow to collect garbage.
