## COMMUNITY HALL PRICING

Due to the increasing cost of everything council has no choice but to increase pricing at the community hall. This will include any new booking beginning on January 1, 2023. See pricing below:

Weddings (Hall rental includes Thursday to Sunday) - \$400.00

Event without bar services —\$75.00

Event with bar services—\$150.00

Small events such as kids birthday parties, baby/bridal showers, meetings etc. that only require 2 or 3 hours at the hall—\$50.00

There will be an additional fee of \$100 for cleaning if we have to clean.

### **COYOTEE SIGHTINGS!**

There has been a concern brought to the office about coyotes being on someone's property. The department of wildlife has been notified and a trap has been set up. The officer said that coyotes are really hard to catch and has asked that any resident who sees a coyote close to their property to contact the office. If they continue to hang around the community we will work with wildlife on a plan.

### **SNOW!!!!**

Please be sure that you have your garbage box and a path (if required to get to the box) cleared of snow on garbage day. If it is not cleared your garbage will not be taken. It is too time consuming and difficult to be cleaning off the top of garbage boxes or trying to get through deep snow to collect garbage.

### PLEASE BE ADVISED: It is illegal to dump snow onto a public roadway.

This notice is for those locals who push snow across a public roadway, which leads to narrowing of roads, the buildup of snow that can be dangerous to motorists, and a nuisance to other residents. A number of cases have been reported to the council office and further action will have to be taken. The RCMP will be notified and asked to keep an eye out.

### DISCOUNTS

There is a smaller discount available for February. If your current year taxes are paid in full by February 28th you are entitled to a 3% discount. Any resident who turns 65 years of age in 2023 will be eligible for an additional 5% senior's discount. You may be exempt from Poll Tax if your previous year's income is below the basic personal exemption for the previous year. The amount for 2022 was \$12,069.00. You must have a copy of last year's tax return notice of assessment to qualify.
