ELECTRONIC PAYMENT OPTION FOR TAXES

If you would like to pay your taxes online, you can do this in two ways:

- You can set up the town as a biller in your online banking. Search for "Reidville, Town of" in the list of billers. Your account number is located on your invoice on the top left corner under your mailing address.
- You can send an email transfer to the town using the email address: townofreidville@nf.aibn.com Use **taxes** as the password.

SNOW CLEARING

PLEASE BE ADVISED: It is illegal to dump snow onto a public roadway, the RCMP have been notified and will be making rounds!!

This notice is for those locals who push snow across a public roadway, which leads to narrowing of roads, the buildup of snow that can be dangerous to motorists, and a nuisance to other residents. A number of cases have been reported to the council office and memos have been passed out to these individuals.

Please be sure that you have your garbage box and path (if required to get to the box) cleared of snow on garbage day. If it is not cleared your garbage will not be taken. It is too time consuming and difficult for the contractor to be cleaning off the top of garbage boxes or trying to get through deep snow to collect garbage.

MAIN DAMN SPILL

Deer Lake Power advises residents of Deer Lake and surrounding communities of a potential controlled release of water from Grand Lake. Water will be released over Main Dam, down Junction Brook and into the Upper Humber River starting March 21, 2022. Water levels and flows may become higher than normal, and people are advised to use caution.
