## MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Council elections across Newfoundland and Labrador will be held September 28th. Any person is qualified to be nominated for a position on council providing they reach the following criteria:

Is a Canadian Citizen of the full age of 18 years.

Is a resident for a period of six (6) months before nomination day either in the municipality or in an area that on Election Day is part of the municipality.

Is not in arrears of taxes or other charges payable to the municipality.

This would be for a 4 year term and would be a great opportunity to give back to your community. Please think about putting your name on a ballot!! Nomination days will be held on September 1st and 2nd from 9 am to 4 pm. There will be further information posted on the town Facebook page, the bulletin boards, as well as a mail-out next week.
