The town of Reidville is currently seeking one additional individual to work on a 14 week Job Creation Partnership Project. This project will consist of renovating the fire hall and groundwork around the community center. The Job Creation Partnership program shall only be used to assist eligible individuals who:

1. Are a resident of the province;
2. Are Canadian citizens or permanent residents legally entitled to work in Canada
3. Meet the definition of EI-eligible;
  - a. An active EI claimant; or,
  - b. Had a benefit period that ended within the previous 60 months
