MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Mark your calendar- every resident, 18 years or older, is urged to get out and vote from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 28th, at the community hall.

Did you know...that if you are unable to be present for voting on Election Day, that you can have someone vote for you. This is called voting by proxy. All you have to do is drop by the office before Election Day, pick up an application and the process will be explained to you - so if you are planning to be out of town that day, your vote can still count!

Please exercise your right and help choose your council who will lead you for the next four years.
