# **DOG DROPPINGS**

The Town is aware that some people use the ball field to let their dogs off leash. We have noticed that some residents are not cleaning up after their animal. While the town has no issue with residents using the field, we ask that you clean up after your pet. This is not a dog park so ensure that you have bags with you - there are outside garbage bins in the playground and in front of the hall for disposal. If this continues, the town will have to start locking the gates and install video surveillance.

## CEEP

The town has recently applied for trail work under the Community Employment Enhancement Program for the fall. If we are successful we will require employees who need 400 hours or less to qualify for Employment Insurance. The town normally gets a call in early fall to see how many hours we need. If this is something you qualify for or would like more information on please call the office.

This is extremely dangerous for both the rider and horse as these bridges were not built to withstand that weight. They are intended for foot traffic only!
