JOB OPPORTUNITY

The town of Reidville has received Community Enhancement Employment Program funding and is seeking workers. We require up to 11 workers to work on our community trail system. The expected project start date is: November 23rd, 2020. Names should be submitted to the town office by noon, Monday, November 16th. These positions pay minimum wage, individuals must be currently unemployed to be eligible to work on the project, individuals must provide all previous records of employment since their last EI application if within the last 52 weeks, individuals can be employed for a minimum of 120 hours up to 400 hours, individuals must qualify for EI by the end of the project.
