BUDGET 2021

There will be a small decrease in the mill rate this year. The rate will decrease from 5.40% to 5.25%, the water rate remains the same at \$338, poll tax and business tax minimum will remain the same at \$300 for the 2021 year.

Council has adopted the following Budget for the 2021 taxation year as follows:
