BUDGET 2024

There will be a small increase in the mill rate this year due to the increase in operating costs. The rate will increase from 5.75% to 6%, the water rate remains the same at \$338, poll tax has been eliminated as per the new municipalities act that will come into effect in the new year and business tax minimum will remain the same at \$300 for the 2024 year.

Council has adopted the following Budget for the 2024 taxation year as follows:
